- 1) All contestants must live within a 60 mile radius of Vidalia, Georgia, and must not have been a previous winner in her age division.
- 2) Only the first 30 applications received for each category will be accepted. The categories are as follows:
 - Little Miss Onion Toddler (Ages 2-3)
 - Little Miss Onion Seed (Ages 4-5)
 - Little Miss Onion Sprout (Ages 6-9)
 - Little Miss Spring Onion (Ages 10-12)
- 3) A Miss Photogenic contest will be held in connection with this pageant. Only first place trophies will be awarded in each age division. Submit an 8" x 10" or 5" x 7" color or black/white picture with entry form and fee.
****picture must be turned in at Friday night practice****
****picture must be picked up the day of the pageant****
- 4) Entry fees are as follows: **\$50.00 for Pageant**
\$20.00 for Photogenic

- 5) Each contestant must secure her own sponsor.
- 6) Out-of-town judges will perform all judging. **ABWA will not provide judges score sheets.**
- 7) **NO parents** will be allowed backstage – there will be persons backstage to make sure your child is properly cared for and gets where she needs to be.

- 8) The queen of each age division will be a special guest of the Miss Vidalia Onion Pageant that night and will be recognized on stage at that event. She will also receive a crown, a trophy, a banner, and flowers from ABWA.
- 9) Only participants in the Miss Onion Toddler, Miss Onion Seed and Miss Onion Sprout Pageants will receive a participation award.
- 10) If your child is a winner of any of the 4 categories – ABWA will apply to have her as a dignitary in the Vidalia Christmas Parade but the winner will be responsible for providing transportation in the parade unless ABWA notifies otherwise.
